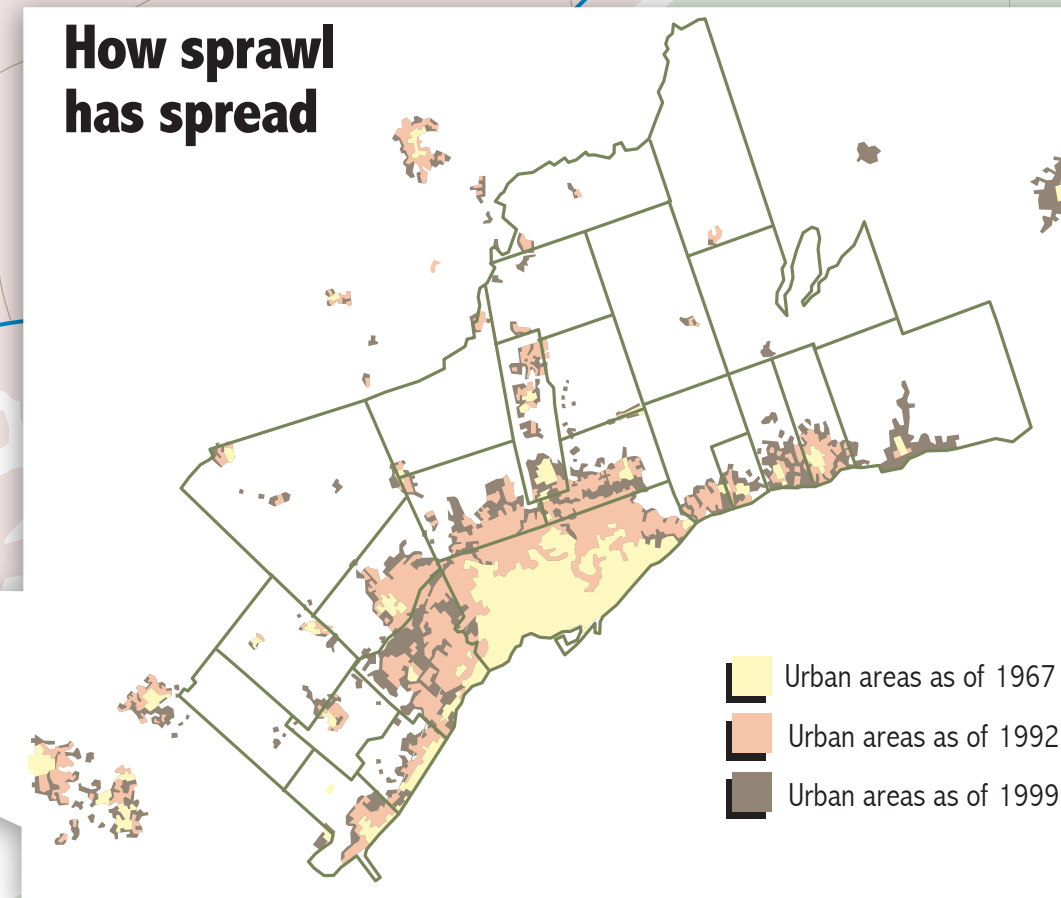
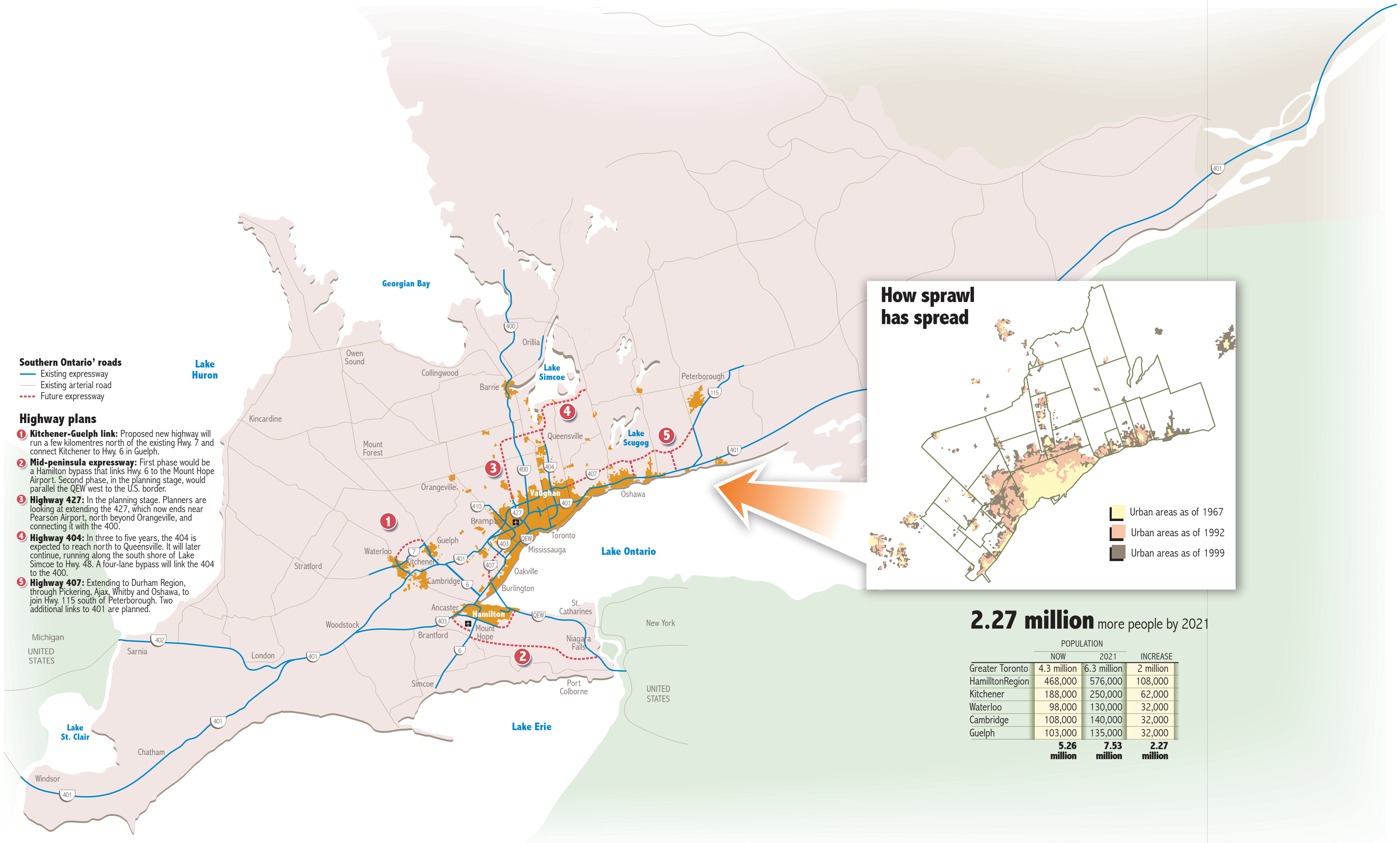


Southern Ontario' roads

Highway plans

- 1 Kitchener-Guelph link:** Proposed new highway will run a few kilometres north of the existing Hwy. 7 and connect Kitchener to Hwy. 6 in Guelph.
- 2 Mid-peninsula expressway:** First phase would be a Hamilton bypass that links Hwy. 6 to the Mount Hope Airport. Second phase, in the planning stage, would parallel the QEW west to the U.S. border.
- 3 Highway 427:** In the planning stage. Planners are looking at extending the 427, which now ends near Pearson Airport, north beyond Orangeville, and connecting it with the 400.
- 4 Highway 404:** In three to five years, the 404 is expected to reach north to Queensville. It will later continue, running along the south shore of Lake Simcoe to Hwy. 48. A four-lane bypass will link the 404 to the 400.
- 5 Highway 407:** Extending to Durham Region, through Pickering, Ajax, Whitby and Oshawa, to join Hwy. 115 south of Peterborough. Two additional links to 401 are planned.
